Growing Need for Care

Halton's older adult population has increased by almost 23% in the last five years (Statistics Canada). In Burlington, there are now more older adults than there are children.

No question, this is a challenging time to be on the front lines of elder care – and we're feeling the pinch.

Last year we provided an extraordinary 289,992 hours of personal care (up 19% from the previous year), and 111,996 nursing visits (up 4% from the previous year). This is the day in, day out care people need to live well at home. Our staff went above and beyond to make it happen.

Our waiting lists for programs are longer than they've ever been. In our volunteer programs, waiting lists are now 50% higher than normal levels. In our Adult Day Programs, wait times for accessing the program are between 6-11 months. This feels like an eternity when you're waiting for help.

12% more families turned to us for emotional support at the end of life and through the grieving process - reminding us that mental well-being is just as important as physical care.

In the coming year, Acclaim Health is gearing up to meet these challenges and to continue to deliver extraordinary community care to those who need it.

The Impact of Extraordinary Care*

- 100% of clients are able to live independently because of a visit from a volunteer
- 99% of families are better able to cope when a loved one chooses to die at home
- 99% of clients had sufficient involvement in establishing their care / treatment plan
- 98% of caregivers are less stressed caring for their loved one with dementia
- 98% of caregivers can keep their relative at home longer because of the Adult Day Program
- 97% of clients feel safer because of a telephone call from their volunteer
- 91% of clients improved their strength, mobility and endurance through the Home Support Exercise Program


