Comprehensive Advanced Palliative Care Education (CAPCE)

The Comprehensive Advanced Palliative Care Education (CAPCE) program is an immersive experience into the "art" and "science" of providing high quality, best evidence-informed palliative care.

The program embeds best practice standards and aligns with the Model to Guide Hospice Palliative Care.

CAPCE focuses on the development and role of the nurse as a Hospice Palliative Care resource for the interprofessional team in long-term care homes, agencies, hospitals and communities. This program will take approximately 5 months to complete and there are a maximum of 10 learners per class. Available for nurses/NPs working in the regions of Halton/Peel.

Blended-Learning Program Components:

- Completion of Fundamentals Enhanced Session (first CAPCE class)
- Case-based learning sessions (four sessions x 4 hours each, in-class, live virtual learning)
- Coaching sessions (six sessions x 2 hours each, in-class, live virtual learning). Each coaching session is mandatory. There will be 3 time slots for each coaching session and you will be asked to only choose one. Dates will be provided at your first in-class session.
- Peer-to-Peer Exchanges / Learning Debriefs (four sessions)
- Practical Application Assignments (x2)
- E-learning Modules (x6)
- Self-directed reading and reflection
- Approximately 5 hours of independent study time per week

<u>All</u> program components are mandatory, including attendance at all learning sessions, to receive a certificate of completion.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria for Applicants:

- Completion of the Fundamentals of Hospice Palliative Care Core Program (some exceptions may be considered on an individual basis)
- Be a NP, RN, or RPN
- Meet the eligibility and selection criteria for applicants (based on the applicant's answers to questions in the application form). See more details at www.acclaimhealth.ca/CAPCE
- Access to an internet-enabled computer or mobile device
- Minimum of 1-year experience (or equivalent as determined by the CAPCE coordination team) caring for people with a progressive, life-limiting illness
- Must be able to attend all sessions
